When you are not sweating it out on the squash court, the following are some of the many things to keep you occupied while in Dunedin.

The Otago Peninsula:

The Otago Peninsula is a stunning piece of New Zealand coastline filled with winding roads, outstanding views and littered with lovely small settlements to enjoy a coffee. Take the time to explore and experience some of the long, attractive beaches frequently occupied by seals and penguins (Allans Beach, Sandfly Bay).

Albatross Sanctuary, Peninsula:

Be amazed.... The world's only mainland breeding colony of Royal Albatross at the end of the Otago Peninsula.

Monarch wildlife tours and cruises:

See the best of the Otago Peninsula and its wildlife onboard the 'MV Monarch'. Whilst onboard, also learn about the fascinating history and geology of the Dunedin area.

Speight's Brewery Tour:

Don't just drink it; check out how it is made! A Dunedin icon since 1876. See, smell, touch and taste the ingredients that go into making Speight's range of beers (as well as tasting the finish product of course).

Lan Yuan - Dunedin Chinese Gardens:

The Chinese Gardens are a very peaceful and relaxing way to spend an hour. The authentic architecture and construction provides an intoxicating tranquility only made better by the availability of delicious Chinese green tea.

St Clair & St Kilda Beaches:

Moana Pool:

Moana Pool is a fantastic way to relax after a hard day of squash. With a lane pool, diving pool, wave pool, hydro slide and spa, there is something for everyone. Located above the Octagon. Take the opportunity to see where Danyon Loader became a champion!

The Dunedin Railway Station:

Described by many as the most beautiful railway station in the world it is also home to the New Zealand Sports Hall of Fame.

Toitu - Otago Settler's Museum:

Experience Dunedin's history at New Zealand's newest, interactive and innovative Museum. Learn about the people whose character, culture, technology, art, fashion, and transport shaped New Zealand's first great city.

Otago Museum:

Open daily, Otago Museum offers a wide variety of galleries and exhibitions including the animal attic, the tropical forest, maritime history, Pacific cultures, nature and The Tangata Whenua Gallery (southern Maori life).





Otago Farmer's Markets:

Taste, smell and feel Otago, 8:00 am - 12:30pm at the Dunedin Railway Station every Saturday morning.

Dunedin Casino:

Lost your squash or having a dream run? Chance your arm at the Dunedin Casino, only a 5 minute walk south of the Octagon.

Botanical Gardens:

New Zealand's first botanic garden. Situated in North Dunedin, it occupies over 30 hectares, features over 6,800 plant species and a variety of native birds.

Port Chalmers and the Orokanui Sanctuary:

Port Chalmers is a small, vibrant village with a selection of bars, cafes and also a variety of shops with local and creative artists and jewelers. Orokonui Ecosanctuary offers visitors both guided tours and self-guided walking, taking in some of New Zealand's rarest birds, reptiles and plants all within the largest protected forest in the South Island.

Cycle The Loop Otago Harbour:

Cycle The Loop around the Otago Harbour and visit some of the best things to do in Dunedin, along the way. What a way to spend a couple of hours, or the whole day! Hire a bike from local businesses.
